

2021-2022 plantation campaign

The initial goal of the 2021-2022 planting campaign is to reach 5,560 trees and 2,803 shrubs distributed throughout the city's green areas, public roads and gardens.

The Seville City Council, through the Delegation of Ecological Transition, has started the 2021-2022 planting campaign, which has the initial objective of reaching 5,560 trees and 2,803 shrubs distributed throughout the green areas, public roads and gardens of the city. This is one of the largest planting programmes carried out in the city, which will focus on the diversification of species and which has the participation of the City Council with a budget of 400,000 euros for the acquisition of specimens, from groups and private companies.

Since 2016, an annual plan has been developed with investments and taking advantage of the resources available in tree conservation and maintenance contracts to reach an average of 5,000 trees per year. To date, these campaigns have allowed the incorporation of 18,000 trees and more than 25,000 shrubs.

Objectives of the 2021-2022 planting campaign

- 2,271 trees on public roads
- 2,704 specimens in large parks
- 500 trees in historic gardens
- 89 in other green areas
- 2,271 trees on public roads
- 2,803 bushes.

This campaign also stands out for the diversity of selected species, including tipuanas, ash trees and jacarandas.

The planting campaign has started in the Vega de Triana Park, a large green lung of 68 hectares, where the planting of 120 tipuanas and 42 ash trees is planned using its own resources. Furthermore, thanks to the agreements reached with institutions and entities, the actions in this campaign for the area will be expanded with 1,350 more units in the park.



2021-2022 Campaign

Following the recent rains and the drop in temperatures in the city, the Parks and Gardens Service of the Seville City Council has begun the 2021-22 planting campaign, which will continue until spring with an initial forecast of 5,564 trees and 2,803 bushes in streets, parks and gardens. This volume of trees does not include those planned by the Municipal Public Works Department in the city's public schools, which will reach 342 specimens.

TREES

Of the total volume of trees, 3,694 units correspond to the Parks and Gardens Service itself, distributed according to two criteria, with 1,921 units on public roads, 89 in gardens and 1,184 in the large parks of the capital of Seville.

In addition, there are 500 trees in the historic gardens, mainly in María Luisa Park.

Through public-private collaboration, another 1,870 new trees are being added, of which 350 are being provided by the public company Emasesa as compensation for the works carried out in the city and its projects to combat climate change, and which will be entirely used for streets and squares; 350 come from the association Red Sevilla por el Clima; 1,000 will be provided by Astrazéneca for a congress whose venue will be Seville; for the same reason, another 100 will be provided by the Congress of Surgery and Traumatology and, finally, 70 will be provided by the Endesa Foundation and the environmental organisation SEO Birdlife.

In the first case, that of Emasesa, its trees will be added to those destined for public roads, while the rest will swell the tree masses of the Vega de Triana Park, the Expo slope and the Pinar de la Ranilla.

The planning of this campaign follows the criteria of the Master Plan for Urban Trees in Seville. On the one hand, the distribution of trees is done according to two priorities: planting in public roads, so that empty tree pits are progressively eliminated and the existing units are increased in streets, squares and other public spaces in the city, with an increase in shaded areas, and the growth of tree masses in parks and gardens.

SPECIES

The Master Plan also establishes a diversification of tree species. Thus, for this campaign there are more than fifty species of trees, taking into account functional criteria (among them, adaptation to the soil and climate of Seville and providing shade), landscape and cultural criteria.

The initial forecast for the distribution of species for this campaign is as follows:

SHRUBBERY

As for the bushes, which contribute to reinforcing the green mass and absorbing rainwater, in addition to their landscape value and improving the habitability of the areas, it has been initially planned to plant 2,803, with the public road as their main destination.
