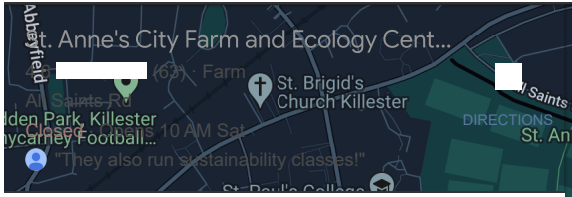
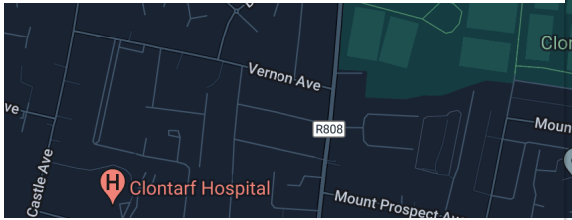


St. Anne's City Farm and Ecology Centre Reviews
